The following definitions apply to the conditions of eligibility for this election:

MEMBERS

All persons who have received the Sacrament of Holy Baptism with water in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, whether in this Church or in another Christian Church, and whose Baptisms have been duly recorded in this Church, are members thereof. (National Canons, 1.17.1a)

COMMUNICANTS IN GOOD STANDING

All communicants of this Church who for the previous year have been faithful in corporate worship, unless for good cause prevented, and have been faithful in working, praying, and giving for the spread of the Kingdom of God, are to be considered communicants in good standing. (National Canons, 1.17.3)

QUALIFIED VOTERS

The qualified voters of the congregation shall be adult members of the congregation, who have been regular contributors to the income of the congregation for the 6 months next preceding the meeting of the Congregation. (Diocesan Canons, XIII.2) Persons age sixteen and above are to be considered adults for purposes of voting.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

Officers of Christ Church shall be

1. Confirmed adult communicants in good standing, and
2. Qualified voters of the Parish. For the purposes of standing for office, the term “adult” shall be defined by state law. (Diocesan Canons, XIV.2a)
3. While not a REQUIREMENT, serving in this Office requires a considerable commitment of time. Please do not agree to run if you are unprepared to meet this commitment.
