**HOLY LAND LENTEN PILGRIMAGE
FEBRUARY 2009**

Fr. Robert and Nancy McNaul extend a cordial invitation to Christ Church parishioners to join them on an unforgettable Pilgrimage to walk in the steps of Jesus Christ in his homeland! Our tour will include breakfast and dinner each day, deluxe hotel accommodations in Tel Aviv, Galilee, and Jerusalem, with expert Christian guides and an air-conditioned chauffeured motor coach.

Some of the highlights the Pilgrimage will include: a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, going to Mount Carmel, (where the prophet Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal), viewing the Mount of the Beatitudes, Caesarea, Qumran (site of the famous Dead Sea Scrolls), the mountain fortress of Masada, and a host of sites in Jerusalem including the Upper Room, walking the Via Dolorosa, and visiting the famous Wailing Wall. We will share Holy Eucharist in the Garden of Gethsemene. There will also be time for leisure, reflection, and of course, for shopping.

The cost for the tour, including round-trip air fare from Los Angeles, is \$3100 per person-this will "flex" slightly in the next few months due to the cost of fuel.
