Christ Church Schedules Dedication Concerts for New Schantz Pipe Organ

Two dedication concerts of Christ Church's new 54 rank Schantz Pipe Organ have been scheduled for February. Due to the high interest expressed, it was decided to offer the two Dedication Concerts. The first concert will be held on Thursday, February 4, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. and will include a short service where our new organ will be blessed and dedicated. The concert will then commence followed by a reception in the Parish Hall. Christ Church parishioners, their extended families, and members our sister Episcopal parishes are invited to attend this concert.

On Friday, February 5, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. the organ will be dedicated again prior to the concert beginning. This concert will be open to the public. A reception will follow in the Parish Hall. The concerts on both nights will be identical. You may attend both concerts if you wish.

Featured organists will be Mrs. Alice Hohenthauer (organist at Christ Church for seventeen years), Dr. Paul Hesselink (current organist at Christ Church), and Mr. Ty Woodward (Schantz Organ Representative).

Works by J. S. Bach, Johannes Brahms, Dieterich Buxtehude, Francois Couperin, Larry Visser, Robert Schumann, John Cook and others will be performed.
